

Updated email template and instructions for the 2023-2024 year:

Please follow the following instructions if you would like to submit a reimbursement form online:

- 1) As usual, have the reimbursee digitally fill out the following [Reimbursement Form](#). Make sure to have an executive member of the team digitally sign the bottom of the form as well.
 - a) **Please note: Reimbursements must be filed within 30 days of the purchase**
- 2) Once filled, have the reimbursee email the signed form to VP Finance at "vp.finance.uoftmedsoc@gmail.com" and to the Medsoc manager's email "medical.society@utoronto.ca"; make sure to cc another exec member on the email as well.
- 3) On the same email, make sure to provide **scanned receipts of the expenses**. Please make sure that the receipts are part of the same pdf document as the reimbursement form (**otherwise we will not process your application**).

- 4) Title the pdf: Name of Organization_Full Name of Reimbursee_Date of Event

If I do not submit original physical receipts prior to this date when requested, I acknowledge that my club and I will be subject to financial penalties, including a request to return reimbursed funds back to the Medical Society. I acknowledge that physical receipts, if they exist for my expense, may need to be collected for the UofT Medical Society to comply with CRA auditing standards.
